The cost is a surprise. Is there assistance available?



Private Instruction is highly encouraged. Consistent 1:1 instruction and accountability from a performing professional is the most effective way to rapidly increase technical proficiency and individual confidence.





Frequently Asked Questions

My student will be out of town for summer training camp. Can they still participate?

Summer Training Camp attendance is essential to a student's success throughout the entire fall season. The foundational skills built at this camp are difficult to "catch up" on and students who do not attend find themselves behind their peers. If you have a concern, please contact Mr. Sampayan directly and decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis.

My student has a heavy class load and the time commitment is a concern. Are there resources to support academic success?

Perry High School provides free tutoring to students after school, and the Regiment rehearsal schedule allows time for students to meet with teachers or attend tutoring any day of the week.

Does my student need to be enrolled in both 7th hour marching band and an ensemble class during the day?

Yes, all students are expected to be enrolled in a band or percussion class during the regular school day. If this is a concern for you and your student, please contact Mr. Sampayan directly.

The cost is a surprise. Is there assistance available?

There is financial assistance available. Please contact Mr. Sampayan directly to discuss opportunities for support. Participation fees are tax credit deductible. Any Arizona resident can make a tax credit contribution on behalf of a specific student, or to the band as a whole.

The cost of the equipment (bags, track suits, shoes) is not detailed. Is there a list of these items and which are required, and which are optional?

Required for All Members: Show Shirt, Travel Uniform Pants and Jacket

Winds members: MTX Marching Shoes, Under Uniform Shirt, Under Uniform Shorts, Gloves, Lyre, and Flip Folder

Percussion Members: MTX Marching Shoes, Under Uniform Shirt, Under Uniform Shorts, and Wristbands

Color Guard Members: Jazz Shoes, Body Tights (individually purchased)

Optional Items: Embroidered Duffle Bag, Color Guard Gloves, Embroidered Guard Flag Bag, Regiment Corp Jacket Prices for these items can fluctuate due to supply availability. If purchasing all required items for the first time, anticipate a total contribution of \$215 - \$250 for winds and percussion members, and \$185 - \$200 for Color Guard members.

Actual cost will be available during purchase at band camp.

I don't know other parents in the program. Is there someone in the program I can reach out to?

Any booster board member would love to hear from you! In addition, parents in each instrument section are available to help answer questions and help both you and your student transition successfully into the program.

I work a full-time job and may not be able to support by volunteering time. Are there other ways I can support the program?

Of course! Any adult family members are welcome and encouraged to contribute their time. If you have means to offer personal financial support or support through your business, financial support is as great a need as volunteer hours. If you're looking to make a more specific donation, consider exploring the Perry Bands Wishlist, found at www.perrybands.com/wishlist. Participation in all fundraising efforts will also benefit the program. Tax Credit Deduction

Arizona law ARS 43-1089.01 enables taxpayers a tax credit contribution of up to \$400.00 per calendar year if filing status is Married, filing Joint Return; \$200.00 per calendar year if filing status is Single or Head of Household; and, \$200.00 per calendar year if filing status is Married filing separate return – for contributions that fund extracurricular activities in public schools. A tax credit is a full refund, not a deduction.
